- 1. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS** - Lynn Moses, Chair (1 min.)
- 2. GENERAL PUBLIC COMMENT** (10 min.) The public may provide comments to the committee on nonagenda items within the Neighborhood Councils subject matter jurisdiction. However, please note that under the Brown Act, the committee is prevented from acting on the issue you bring to its attention until the matter is agendaized for discussion at a future public meeting. (Limited to 2 minutes per speaker.)
- 3. CHAIR APPOINTS COMMITTEE MEMBERS** In accordance with the ASNC Standing Rules, all standing committees must include a minimum of three and a maximum of 11 members. The members may include a co-chair and a secretary to take the minutes. Members remain on the committee until they resign, have two unexcused absences and/or a new Board is seated. Quorum shall be 50% plus one as required to hold a meeting. A simply majority of the quorum present may pass motions. Committees have no authority, except when specified by the Board, other than to make recommendations to the ASNC Board.
