- 3. CITY-WIDE WIFI** (5 min.) Discussion and possible action to support the Los Angeles City Council's Innovation Technology and General Services Committee motion, Council File 130953, to implement wireless broadband for all of Los Angeles. A positive vote may lead to a motion for the ASNC to issue a Community Impact Statement on the matter.
- 4. RAINWATER RECLAMATION PROJECT** (5 min.) Discussion and possible action to support the proposed local water reclamation project. The plan is being considered by North East Trees and has been endorsed by the Debs Park Advisory Board. Runoff from winter storms from the western section of Montecito Heights will be routed into a system of underground cisterns and solar-powered pumps to be used to irrigate Debs Park and Montecito Park and to alleviate flooding in the area.
