- 3. CONVENING OF ELECTION OUTREACH COMMITTEE** Members may not be ASNC candidates.
- 4. ELECTION TIMELINE AND CRITICAL DATES** Discussion of election milestones and goals for each. For instance, the candidate deadline is February 7th. What should be accomplished before then? What outreach events should be held and when, in order to support candidate recruitment and Election Day May 21, 2016.
- 5. ELECTION PRINT CAMPAIGN** Discussion of print media: newsletters, postcards, advertisements. Estimate the print budget to be considered at the Budget & Finance Committee and ASNC Board approval.
- 6. STORAGE SHELVING** Purchase wire shelving for storage space from Operations funds, up to \$100.
- 7. HOMELESS DONATION FLYER** To promote campaign to collect items for local homeless, up to \$100 Outreach funds.
- 8. WILDLIFE TOWNHALL REFRESHMENTS** Dec. 1 at Ramona Hall not to exceed \$100 Outreach from Smart & Final or similar.
- 9. POPCORN MACHINE** Purchase popcorn machine with Outreach funds, up to \$600 (8 oz machine \$180, 8-oz machine with cart \$250, 16-oz capacity no cart \$600 plus tax) from Amazon or similar.
- 10. NORTHEAST LOS ANGELES HOLIDAY PARADE** ASNC participation, volunteer refreshments \$200, program ad \$400
- 11. MONTECITO REC CENTER GIFT GIVEAWAY** Consider expenditure of up to \$600 for goodie bags and small gifts purchased from Holiday Goo, Ms. Teddy Bear or similar for annual community holiday event at Montecito Heights Rec Center.
- 12. RAMONA HALL HOLIDAY MOVIE NIGHT** Consider expenditure of up to \$300 for refreshments from Smart & Final or similar to support a holiday movie night at Ramona Hall, date to be determined.
- 13. RAMONA HALL COMMUNITY HOLIDAY CELEBRATION** Consider expenditure of up to \$1000 for gift bags and small presents from Holiday Goo, Ms. Teddy Bear or similar for annual community holiday event at Ramona Hall on December 18.
- 14. FIG JAM NPG** \$1000 for supplies to create murals installed on Figueroa between Ave 50-60 on Feb. 13, 2016. Requested by North Figueroa Association, a 501(c)3. Will require waiving \$500 NPG spending limit.
