6. MURDERS IN ROSE HILL PARK Hollenbeck officials have been invited to discuss the recent murders of two young women whose bodies were found in the Rose Hill area of Debs Park. Rumors and speculation have created alarm in the public. The discussion will center on facts and issues related to the ongoing investigation.

SCHOOL SAFETY AT ARROYO SECO MUSEUM SCIENCE MAGNET SCHOOL Traffic calming and other measures to improve pedestrian safety at Sycamore Terrace and Figueroa where K thru 8th grade students walk regularly to school.
