GENERAL PUBLIC COMMENT – None

Item 4 on Agenda: Bad timing of gates and signals allow approximately 12 cars to back up on Ave 45 from Mt. Washington. Suggested traffic signal status be changed to blinking yellow on Marmion Way and blinking red on Avenue 45 to allow left and right turns onto Marmion Way. Suggested right turn only lane on Avenue 45.

Item 5 on Agenda: No real problem.

Item 6 on Agenda. Some objection to change to one-way streets because of large trucks being unable to make the sharp turns, problems with exiting driveways, problems for pedestrians crossing. Car parking on curves causes danger due to restricted sight lines. Speeding is an issue but would increase with change to one-way streets and removal of car parking. Funding for “20 is Plenty” signage will be sought by Mt. Washington residents.

Item 7 on Agenda: Removal of parking was objected to by residents and could result in speed increases and danger to pedestrians due to increased crossing distances as well as speeding.

Freeway 710 extension status: No change this month. Stakeholders are being polled for option preferences.

Future agenda items: No new items proposed at this time.
