Minutes of March March 26, 2015 meeting approved

GENERAL PUBLIC COMMENT – None

Item 4 on Agenda: Installation of ADA compliant ramps for pedestrian bridge over I110 to Sycamore Grove park. Present condition precludes pedestrians with wheeled devices (wheelchairs, strollers, bicycles, carts) from using the bridge in either direction to access: Sycamore Grove park, Audubon Center, Montecito park athletic fields, Montecito Senior Center from car parking areas on Figueroa Street, Ave 39, Griffin Avenue. Roy Payan feels that use of the bridge should be discouraged for safety reasons.

Item 5 on Agenda: Recent car crash on Figueroa at Marmion/Pasadena Ave, apparently due to lack of adequate sight line from left turn lane to northbound traffic on Fig because of bend in the road at that point. Traffic study to be requested, Sylvia Robledo to be notified.

Item 6 on Agenda. Current proposal for street improvements on North Figueroa from Ave 55 to Ave 60 may include bike lanes. Updated status of alternatives now under consideration different than previous public meetings. Additional meetings to take place, not yet announced.

Item 7 on Agenda: Damage to Montecito Drive due to seal/slurry coat application. Roy Payan has contacted BOSS to repair damage. No response yet.

Future agenda items: No new items proposed at this time.
