EXTEND CURB FOR DRAINAGE** Recommend to the ASNC Board that a letter be written to CD1 and Street Services that the curb be extended at 1028 Montecito Drive to 1040 Montecito Drive so that rainwater will be directed down the street instead of running over the hill, which creates erosion and flooding below.
- 5. ASNC ELECTION AND CANDIDATE RECRUITMENT** Paul Bonsell will present information about becoming a candidate for the ASNC. Nomination period ends March 22. The election will be held May 21.
- 6. FLAT TOP DISPOSITION** Recommend that the ASNC Board approve letters to Councilmember Gil Cedillo and Los Angeles County Supervisor Hilda Solis to support the community's wishes that North East Trees adhere to the purchase agreement's original intent as adopted by the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors on September 30, 2014 that the "City of Los Angeles will ultimately be the owner of the property and the successor to the grant obligations," among other points.
