- 5. MOTION:** Request action from LADPW and Rec and Parks to remove obstacles to pedestrian access to various attractions and amenities along the Arroyo ranging from the Lummis Home to Sycamore Grove Park including several venues in between:
  - Improve Carlotta right of way pedestrian path (grade and pave) from Avenue 43 to Sycamore Grove Park. Remove chain link fence across path at Avenue 44.
  - The pedestrian bridge which crosses the I-110 Parkway from Sycamore Grove Park to Avenue 52/ Griffin Avenue is not ADA compliant and presents an obstacle to pedestrians with wheelchairs, walkers, crutches, canes, baby strollers, bicycles or carts. Construction to build ramps in place of stairs is required for ADA compliance
