- 4. Discussion and Action Item:** Request the Public Safety Committee support Assemblyman Gomez' Pet Adoption Day on Sept. 17 in Eagle Rock, and suggest ideas to help promote this event. As well as seek volunteers to assist.
- 5. Discussion and Possible Action Item:** Schedule a meeting to discuss the installation of a Wrought Iron Fence for Debs Park along the Griffin/ Ave. 52 corridor. This meeting should include ASNC reps, LAPD, LAFD, Park Rangers, Audubon Reps and reps from LA City Rec and Parks, as well as any interested communities. The Public Safety Committee will present possible costs quotes, design suggestions and proposals.
- 6. Discussion and Action Item:** The Public Safety Comm. Requests up to \$ 900 to sponsor a CPR Class for up to 20 participants. The funding request will include the rental of the venue and the class will be held at either Ramona Hall or the Montecito Heights Senior Center.
