**MINUTES** Minutes of January 18 approved unanimously.

- 3. PUBLIC COMMENT Drew suggested a townhall on immigration. Roy stated he has contacted Assemblymember Jimmy Gomez and State Senator Kevin de Leon to divest all monies for Dakota and Keystone Pipeline from CALPERS fund and will urge other NCs to do the same. Tamar and Teri will follow up on Mayoral Primary Townhall idea. Valerie will provide Teri with inventory of promo items to move ahead with \$1000 purchase of new items approved by ASNC Board July 2016.
- 4. **HERMON SUBDIVISION MEETINGS** Public meetings to be held March 6th and March 28th with voting Saturday April 8th to be at a location within Hermon, possibly Bushnell Way School. ASNC movie nights at Bushnell and Los Angeles International Charter High School (LAICHS) will provide information as well as at other events.
- 5. **TREE PLANTING IN DEBS PARK** Long time Debs Park supporter/Montecito Heights resident Thomas Berg seeks support for a tree planting in the south end of Debs Park near where the murdered girls were found. Thomas was unable to attend due to a family emergency. Lynda suggested the project be funded as a Community Improvement Project (CIP). Postponed pending budget submission from Thomas.
- 6. BUSHNELL WAY MOVIE NIGHT Request up to \$200 for refreshments and flyers. Proposed March 10 date. Unanimous approval.
- 7. **HERMON DOG PARK EVENT** Britta proposed a back-to-back event with Bushnell movie night. She will contact Ursula of Friends of Hermon Dog Park to seek their participation. Unanimous approval.
- 8. **PROJECTOR FOR CARLIN G** Director Hua Ling requests support to purchase a projector for the Mt. Washington center to expand means of diverting children on rainy days..Lynda will follow up with DONE to confirm we can fund it. Hua will clarify which projector is needed.
- 9. **HILL CHALLENGE RUN** Provide MyTaco or similar buffet at Audubon Center on April 1. Outreach funds up to \$600. Unanimous approval.
- 10. EGG HUNT AT MONTECITO REC CENTER April 13, refreshments and goodie bags up to \$200. Unanimous approval.
- 11. **BASEBALL OPENING DAY** at Montecito Heights Dodger Dream Field April 22. Refreshments up to \$400. ASNC will be shown in program. Unanimous approval.

- 15. **34TH DISTRICT CANDIDATE FORUM** Primary election will be April 4. Monterey Hills LI hosts candidate Jimmy Gomez Feb. 9th. Britta, Roy and Drew will follow up with planning and candidates. Unanimous approval.
