- 4. LOCAL MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES** Discussion to organize a community townhall in collaboration with Los Angeles County Department of Mental Health to provide information about mental health services, crisis response, suicide prevention, and how to access services. This is in response to the recent rash of suicides in the area.
- 5. ISSUES FOR NEW EMD & DONE PUBLIC SAFETY STAFF** ASNC voted February 27 to add two new staff members each to the Emergency Management Department and the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment dedicated to Public Safety matters. The Public Safety Committee will generate guidance as to priorities and issues for the new staff.
- 6. SPEED BUMP LOCATIONS** CD1's Sylvia Robledo recently announced that funding for two speed bumps has come available. The Committee will discuss location recommendations.
- 7. CART MODULES** Continued discussion of converting CERT modules for use by Community Animal Rescue Teams (CART).
- 8. ADJOURNMENT**
