- Susie Lopez of Council District 14's office has confirmed that we will receive our brown shaded benches in Budd Wiener Park. They are working with Recreation and Parks. First, the benches will be installed, then the shades, within the next 1-2 months. Residents have said the sprinklers and irrigation in the park were not properly fixed and that the irrigation is worse than ever. There have also been complaints that the no-smoking signs are not as effective as they face the wrong direction for someone sitting at the benches.

Ms. Lopez has prioritized having no dumping signs installed on Via Marisol. More requests for tree trimming and the requests will be forwarded to Kevin de Leon's team. There is still a hole left from when a fire hydrant burst on Via Arbolada and Via Marisol. A contract had come out and fixed one fire hydrant, and they will look into the one by Linden Heights.

The Hermon Neighborhood Council is still in the very early stages of petitioning to rename Via Marisol to Hermon Avenue in Hermon. There will be a committee of board members and stakeholders that must operate within Hermon, and they are open to community input and will hold public meetings. Ms. Lopez will look into seeing if Monterey Hills representatives can be members of the committee.

Construction for street repairs on Via Marisol will start in February of 2021, and all construction should be finished by March 2022. As they are still in the transition phase into Kevin de Leon's term, the contact information or the staff is not available yet.
