

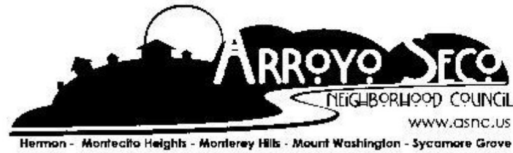

2. **La Casita Verde Acoustic Remediation Plan: \$2500 - Pat Griffith - ACTION ITEM**  
Mt. Washington Preschool and Child Care Centers, Inc. is a community-based non-profit organization that provides quality care for children 6 months to 5 years old in three locations. The room used for the oldest children at the La Casita Verde facility in Sycamore Grove has substandard acoustics that prevent the agency from qualifying for some key subsidies, i.e. Head Start, for low income families as well as impacting the quality of teaching in the room. This funding request will pay for licensed contractors to define the remediation needed to meet Head Start standards.
