- 5. MONTEREY HILLS MOVIE NIGHT** (5 min.) Discussion and possible action to rent a snow-cone machine with generator to enhance outreach at an upcoming movie night at Monterey Hills Budd Weiner Park at an expenditure of approximately \$140 plus \$50 for serving supplies.
