Meeting called to order at 7:02 pm.

Minutes of September 25<sup>th</sup> meeting approved

Public Comment: None

Shuttle Bus Routes: Public transportation needed to access Metro Rail from ASNC extended area discussed, no actions, remains in committee.

Hazardous northbound Avenue 43 exit from I110 Parkway discussed, no action, remains in committee.

Review presentation by Sharon Lowe at September meeting. Bottom line is that no funding is available for development of Arroyo Seco bike path extension to Gold Line station and there are no plans for alternate bike infrastructure on Marmion Way or Monte Vista as had been announced to the Board by Gil Cedillo's staff previously. After the September meeting and presentation, the Chair has been notified that Sharon's presentation was not in compliance with "office protocol", she should not have been asked to present, and she should not have been asked about alternative bicycle infrastructure. Note: correspondence of record indicates otherwise. Sharon Lowe introduced the idea of her presenting at the meeting; the topic of alternate bicycle infrastructure was in her offer.

Announcement: Status of neighborhood purpose grant to LACBC for bicycle safety intervention was approved by Board by a narrow margin of votes. Intervention to take place in December at hitherto undisclosed location.
