RV PARKING ON CARLOTA** On behalf of the Sycamore Grove community, the committee recommends that the ASNC Board to request CD1 take action to restrict RV Parking along the Carlota Street corridor to be limited to 72 hours and ban overnight parking. A similar action was approved for N. Figueroa in the Sycamore Grove Park area.
- 5. SURVEY ON SALES TAX INCREASE TO BENEFIT METRO** Create a community survey regarding a .05 cent sales tax increase to help fund expansion and maintenance of the LA Metro Light Rail system as proposed by Supervisor Hilda Solis.
- 6. 84-UNIT DEVELOPMENT AT FIG & PASADENA AVENUE** Inform the residents of Sycamore Grove and surrounding communities of the proposed 61 ft. high, 84 unit development, that includes a small commercial strip with over 200 parking spaces at the intersection of Pasadena Ave. and N. Figueroa where the recycling center is currently located. This development is dramatically out of scale with the area.
