5. General Public Comment

Ben Park – Cleland Park – there will be Potluck in the Park. 5-8pm this coming Saturday 6/16. Come and enjoy!

Steven Wallace – Working with his husband and Jess and the city, were able to accomplish what they had been fighting for: Speed Humps will now be installed 6/22 to lower speeding near Cleland Park.

6. Marmion Way Crime. Presentation and Q&A with officers from the Northeast Division.

Officer Reyes - Senior Lead Officer for Glassell Park and Cypress Park (substituting for Officer Allen):

- Thefts / Burglaries / Bike thefts happen near RVs and have spilled over onto Marmion Way.
- Parking will now be prohibited from 2-6am – from Monte Vista to where Marmion Way turns into Figueroa.
- June 26 – Homeless Outreach in Cypress Park
- What happens when the RVs just move into the neighborhood for the night? Bring it to Officer Reyes and/or Bill Cody.
- Bill: We're working on Safe Zones for RVs.

- Irma Ramirez (who lives on Marmion): Happy about new signs. But concerned that if the “No Stopping” signs are removed, people will resume living in their cars during the day.
- If you’re experiencing crazy traffic, email Officer Reyes – 33184@lapd.online - and he will pos a motorcycle officer nearby.
- Travis: People sleep overnight by his house. But if it’s there for over 72 hours, and you can prove it with photos, that can help.
- Officer Reyes: call in problems, and also email them in. More emails give them a better paper trail. These signs are going to work.
- *Jess: We’ll invite Officer Allen to next month’s meeting and see if there’s been any progress.*
