Meeting Minutes

1. CALL TO ORDER

Meeting called to order by Jason Berlin at 7:35pm.

2. ROLL CALL

Quorum - Jason Berlin, Ted Cannon, Nicholas Manalo, Sean Singletary.

3. MINUTES

Jason made motion to approve minutes, Ted seconded, approved unanimously.

4. PUBLIC COMMENT

Discussion about failed retaining wall blocking sidewalk on San Rafael, no immediate report of cleanup.

5. Bill Cody - a representative from Gil Cedillo's Office

Is working on issue where roadway appears to be extended on Bend Drive. Arizona Pipeline had dropped a metal plate at Jessica Triangle and crushed landscaping, it was replaced. Bill will look into whether left turn signal is being installed on Eagle Rock at El Paso, and look into pothole status.

6. Cleland Park Update

The gate was locked when request was made to clear the swing radius of debris; need to be unlocked. Off-leash dogs are still an issue, a child was cornered by two off-leash dogs. Community would like additional signage indicating that dogs must be on leash. Bill reported that City staff has been out ticketing in evenings with a dedicated park ranger.

7. Historic Marmion Mile Update

Cyclist was hit by a car at Avenue 43 on Friday, May 3. No update on Great Streets Application.

8. MWAHA Events – Teen Job Fair and Jack Smith Walk

Flyer was distributed describing two community events – a Teen Job Fair at the Mt. Washington Homeowner's Alliance General Meeting on May 13 where Mt. Washington teens will advertise their talents for homeowners to hire for small jobs. Also, the Jack Smith Walk will be on Sunday May 19, in two shifts, a 2.5 hour hike starting at Southwest Museum up the hill to trace the path used by LA Times Writer Jack Smith.
