1. Marmion Dumping Ground: RV trailer that has been here for over a month. At least 3 cars associated with this trailer come and go so they are using this for storage, not for living. Neighbors have reported this and not parking enforcement.
 - i. Many of the recently installed plastic dummy delineator for traffic safety are damaged or completely destroyed. We have had to prop some of the up.
 - ii. Encampments in the gully
 - iii. Note refrigerator and tables demonstrate weekly dumping left behind by street vendors who come for days at a time and camp overnight 3-4 days a week. Every week these vendors dump what they don't sell into the gully.
 - iv. Video of one of my own vehicles getting totaled by speeding driver on August 22, 2020. (crash onto our vehicle at 0:17 minute. Note that this driver slammed into our car head on destroying our trash can and dummy plastic delineators. It is extremely luck that someone did not die as runners and bikers are often on the street.
